Course Title: ORGANIZATION IN ECOLOGICAL ACTIVITY

Credits: 3 (108 h.)

Course objective

Mastering theoretical knowledge and practical skills in the sphere of the state environmental activities management.

Course outlines

Knowledge formation about the structure of environmental activities management, functions and tasks of the state executive and legislative authority in the field of environmental safety, environmental and natural resource management.

Topics of the course contents

Fundamentals of Environmental Policy in Ukraine. The control system in the field of environmental protection and inspectorate. State Legal Department of Environmental Quality. State management and conservation of natural resources. Administrative structure and responsibility distribution in environmental activities. International environmental cooperation. Non-government environmental organizations.

Learning outcomes

After completing the course the students should be able to:

- analyze the state environmental protection and supervision system;
- know the state management and conservation of natural resources;
- know the administrative structure and responsibility distribution in environmental activities;
- analyze the non-government environmental organizations in Ukraine;
- know about the international environmental cooperation;
