

Beginning of cooperation between Dnipro University of Technology and Lancaster University within the framework of the Twinning Initiative

In 2022, Dnipro University of Technology started cooperation with Lancaster University (Great Britain) with the support and coordination of the initiatives of Cormack Consultancy Group within the framework of a strategic partnership between universities of Ukraine and Great Britain.

The company in partnership with Universities UK (https://www.universitiesuk.ac.uk) has launched an initiative called "Twinning Initiative". The essence of the initiative is that your university is twinned with a university from the UK (or the EU) of a similar profile, size and education offer. The twinning initiative will help the Ukrainian university to find a reliable partner that will maintain a direct link between the students and the academic community of both institutions. Partner universities will have a better understanding of the needs and challenges faced by a particular Ukrainian HEI, and will be able to provide the necessary support, targeted and requested. Such support may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Organisation of mobility programmes for students and academics;

- Organisation of access to databases and online courses that students of your university will be able to take for free, receiving credits;

- Access to scientific libraries and repositories;

- Scholarships for short-term postgraduate research;


- Education quality assurance for the period of the education system restoration;

- Fundraising or creation of a fund for the restoration of the Ukrainian HEI or meeting certain targeted needs;

- Cultural and informational, scientific events among students;

- Creation of a partnership for submitting grant applications.

This list is not exhaustive, you can submit your proposals to the partner institution. We believe that this will help deepen the internationalisation of Ukrainian higher education institutions and mitigate the crisis.
