Study sample: People from Ukraine, Aizeberjan, Chile and Chine.

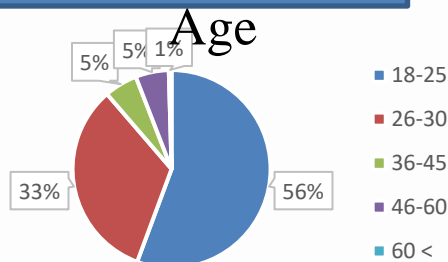
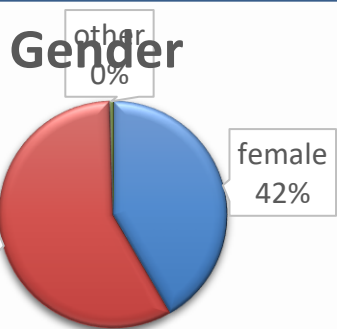

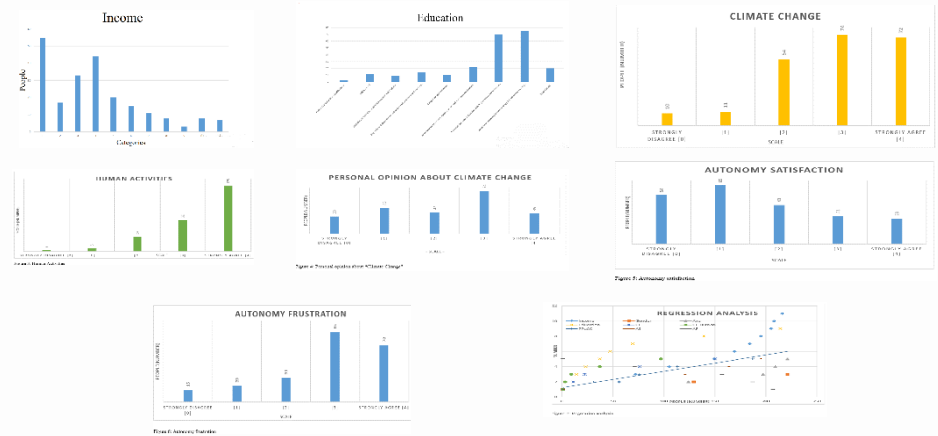
Study design and procedure:
